

## Our oceans are in danger! Poster challenge

### What is my challenge?

Your challenge is to make an eye-catching poster to tell the Prime Minister about what's happening in the oceans, and persuade them that we need global ocean sanctuaries and a strong UN Global Ocean Treaty.

### What will I need?

You will need:

- A sheet of plain paper or card
- A pencil or pen

You could also use:

- Colouring pencils or felt tips
- Paints and a paintbrush
- Old paper (this could be magazines, food wrappers or gift wrap)
- Natural items, like leaves and flower petals, from outside
- Scissors
- Glue

### What could I include?

A good persuasive poster will have pictures that grab the audience's attention. Think bold, eye-catching designs and short powerful phrases.



It is important to have a message that catches your audience's attention. You could use some of the techniques below to make yours stand out.

- Strong adjectives – fragile, precious, magnificent, shocking
- Rhetorical questions – Can you help protect our oceans?
- Powerful verbs – save, stop, protect, destroy, help, rescue
- Alliteration – Sanctuaries for survival!
